Cable theft and vandalism of infrastructure affects customer electricity supply to Vleesbaai residents.

Saturday, 17 June 2023: Eskom is aware of the unplanned power interruption in Vleesbaai due to cable theft. Eskom technicians are unable to access the areas due to heavy mud and treacherous terrain.

They will continue to monitor the situation and will do everything possible to restore the electricity supply to customers as soon as possible.

Inclement weather conditions has created serious challenges for technicians who have to navigate on dangerous terrain to attend to faults, causing delays in electricity restoration efforts across the Western Cape.

Eskom would like to urge customers to treat all electricity as live during this time.

Eskom apologises to its customers for any inconvenience caused.
