
 3^{rd} Review of 2017 – 2022 IDP ightharpoonup 4th Edition : Draft 2020/21 IDP

The IDP is every Municipality's master strategic plan. It is a legislated requirement.

It's development and annual review is done in accordance with Chapter 5 of the Municipal Systems Act 32/2000 and other supporting pieces of legislation, such as the MFMA 56/2003.



Every newly elected Council is responsible for developing its own 5-year IDP. The Council of Dr Beyers Naudé Local Municipality developed its 2017 – 2022 IDP after the August 2016 Elections. It was implemented on 1 July 2017 and has undergone 3 annual reviews. The final review will be conducted later in 2020.



The various phases, as depicted on the left, are followed with each annual review. We are now in the 5th Phase where the Draft IDP has been tabled and is being introduced to communities for discussion and input. The socio-economic development plans of other sectors are also fed into the IDP, and they need to respond to Ward Development Priorities.

Ward-based Plans lay the foundation of the IDP and are also subjected to an annual review. Communities are at the core of our planning processes. Public participation is crucial and is encouraged through various structures & platforms. Ward Committees play a very important role in distributing information and assisting Ward Councillors in keeping their constituencies informed. The developmental needs and critical issues as identified through public participation in our 14 Wards, are aligned with the IDP's five Development Priorities, as listed below.

Due to the Coronavirus / Covid-19 Lockdown and regulations prohibiting public meetings and gatherings, we were unable to hold the Mayoral Outreach meetings that were scheduled to take place in all 14 Wards during the month of April 2020.

The Draft 2020/21 IDP and summary thereof will be posted on our website www.bnlm.gov.za (select/click Key Documents → Statutory Documents → Strategic & Sector Plans) with links on the Municipality's facebook page. Copies of the Draft IDP and Budget will be available for inspection in the reception area of Municipal Offices in all eight towns – as from Tuesday 2 June 2020; Ward Councillors can also assist with queries.

In addition, we will be holding regulated Open Days in our towns – on the dates and at the venues that will be announced. We encourage our residents to make use of these options to inspect the IDP, Budget and related documents and to provide us with your written comments by Monday, 22 June 2020.
