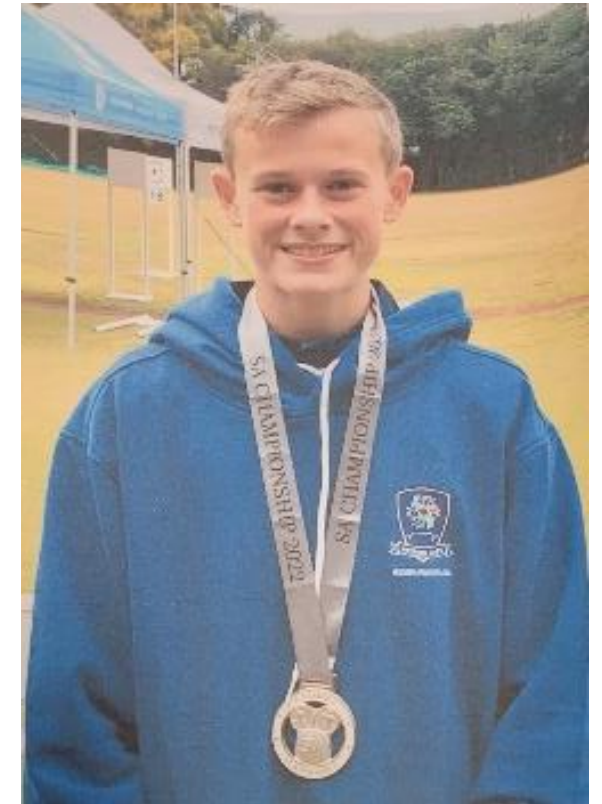
Johan Coenraad Schoeman
