

Federal Executive, noting the report of the sub-committee established to investigate matters in the George Municipality, resolves –

1. To direct the George Caucus to hold a fresh election for the position of Caucus Chairperson;
2. To request the Provincial Executive of the Western Cape to place Mr Melvin Naik, the Mayor of George, on a programme to enhance his leadership, management and conflict-resolution skills for a minimum period of three months, and for the Provincial Chairperson to monitor his performance;
3. To replace Ms Draghoender, Mr Niehaus, Ms Cornelius and Mr Stander on the Mayoral Committee with other councillors: the names of whom must be submitted by the Provincial Executive to the Federal Executive for approval;
4. To transfer Ms Iona Kritzinger and Mr Michael Nyakati to appropriate positions on the Mayoral Committee, and to request the Provincial Executive to nominate appropriate replacements as Speaker and Chief Whip, for the approval of the Federal Executive;
5. To instruct the members of the Caucus to observe lines of communication within the Party;
6. To request the Provincial Executive to replace Mr Tertius Simmers as Constituency Head for the George Constituency with an MP or MPL who is less involved in the Caucus's affairs;
7. To require the FLC to conclude all disciplinary matters involving members of the George caucus as soon as possible;
8. To refer the questions of the possible irregular staff appointments; the alleged irregular EPWP appointments; the alleged irregular expenditure; the MediClinic issue, and the issue of the 10 000 vs 5 000 square metre office space, to the Office of the MEC for Local Government for investigation and possible prosecution;
9. To require all councillors to undergo training inter alia on the caucus rules, the council rules, the Code of Conduct, the duties and responsibilities of councillors and members of Mayco (including the Mayor, Speaker and Chief Whip);
10. To remind members of the ^{caucus} Council that the language of business in the ^{caucus} Council is English, and to require councillors to observe this;
11. To instruct the Executive Director: Statutory Obligations and Support Services and Provincial Managing Director to resolve the outstanding membership issues before the election of delegates to the Federal Congress; and
12. To request the Provincial Executive to consider the appointment of an administrator to oversee compliance to this resolution.

Federal Executive authorises the Provincial Executive to apply this resolution in phases, but requests it to provide regular progress reports, not more than once every three months.
