Severe Weather Alerts

for the Western Cape and western parts of the Northern Cape

Impact-Based Warnings

- A. Orange level 8 warning for disruptive rainfall leading to flooding of roads, bridges and formal and informal settlements, mudslides and danger to life due to fast flowing rivers is expected over the mountainous regions of the Drakenstein, Stellenbosch, the western parts of the Theewaterskloof, City of Cape Town, Breede Valley and Witzenberg local municipalities of the W.Cape from Sunday to Tuesday (10-12/05/2026).
- B. Orange level 6 warning for disruptive rainfall leading to flooding of roads, low-lying bridges, and formal as well as informal settlements is expected over the West Coast, Cape Winelands, and western parts of the Overberg Districts of the W.Cape from Sunday to Tuesday (10-12/05/2026).
- C. Orange level 6 warning for damaging winds and waves leading to danger to navigation at sea and damage to coastal infrastructure is expected along the coast between Lambert's Bay and Plettenberg Bay (W.Cape) from Sunday to Tuesday (10-12/05/2026).
- D. Orange level 5 warning for damaging interior winds leading to damage of formal and informal settlements, power interruptions and closure of some routes due to falling trees is expected over southern parts of the West Coast district, City of Cape Town, Cape Winelands and western parts of the Central Karoo Districts, and the Overstrand Municipality of the W.Cape from Sunday to Tuesday (10-12/05/2026).
- E. Yellow level 4 warning for damaging winds and waves leading to danger to navigation at sea is expected along the coast between Alexander Bay to Lambert's Bay(W.Cape) from Sunday to Tuesday (10-12/05/2026).
- F. Yellow level 2 warning for disruptive rainfall leading to localised flooding of low-lying bridges, and formal as well as informal settlements is expected over the northern parts of the West Coast, eastern parts of the Cape Winelands and Overberg Districts of the W.Cape from Sunday to Tuesday(10-12/05/2026).
- G. Yellow level 2 warning for damaging winds leading to localised damage of informal settlements, falling trees and localised problems for high-sided vehicles on prone routes is expected over parts of the West Coast, and Central Karoo

H. Yellow level 2 warning for disruptive snowfall leading to loss of vulnerable livestock, disruption of traffic due to icy roads and possible closure of mountain passes is expected over the Karoo Hoogland municipality of the N.Cape and in places over the Cape Winelands District of the W.Cape for Sunday (10/05/2026).

I. Yellow level 2 warning for Storm Surge leading to localised flooding of low lying coastal areas is expected between Saldanha Bay and Plettenberg Bay from Monday evening into Tuesday (11-12/05/2026).
